






## Historyfacts' Reseaches

Obituary: Thomas L. Jentz

Following an extended illness endured with courage and patience, Tom Jentz passed away end of December 2012. With his passing we have lost a technical writer and author whose lifework is impossible to overestimate! First collaborating with Walter Spielberger and the artist and researcher Hilary Doyle, then subsequently continuing to work with Doyle alone, Tom authored a number of standard works on the German Armored Troops, and on selected individual German tanks and vehicles of WWII. His doctrine was invariably that only documented facts should be published and all speculation excluded. These were the professional ethics he lived up to, creating in the process a comprehensive body of work with his own publication series "Panzer Tracts" – until poor health sadly denied him the opportunity of completing it entirely. Supported by a well-known author, Hilary Doyle will now continue and complete Tom's work.

I knew Tom as a constructively critical contemporary with strong personal views. In discussions with him about the subject we both so enjoyed, he expressed his opinions in an unequivocal manner – particularly when they differed from my own. Having the possibility to measure oneself verbally and as a fellow author with someone on a par in my own specialist field was an opportunity simply too good to miss. Those discussions were highly enriching and I will remember them for ever!
